



STUDENT ACCIDENT INSURANCE 2017-2018 SCHOOL YEAR

The Lampeter-Strasburg School District provides medical insurance for a child or children attending school in the District. This plan is with United States Fire Insurance Company. The accident insurance plan covers students (Grades K-12) for any school-sponsored and/or supervised activity.

This is a high limit accident insurance plan that also includes football, interscholastic athletics, intramurals, band, and cheerleaders. Doctors, hospitals, and other medical providers are paid at "Usual and Customary" expenses.

This plan will pay secondary to any other insurance under which your children are covered. If there is no other insurance, this plan will pay primary. In the event of school injuries, a claim should first be filed with your carrier. This plan is designed to help supplement any family insurance you might have. Please note that parents must follow their HMO/PPO procedures. Out-of-network services will be paid at 50 percent of Usual and Customary benefit.

This is strictly an accident policy. There are no benefits for illness. Treatment for accidents must begin within 90 days of injury. Claim forms can be obtained in each building's nurse's office or, in the event of an athletic-related accident, through the Athletic Director. Claims must be filed within 90 days of the injury.
