PAYMENT OF SUBSTITUTE TEACHER - TEMPORARY ILLNESS

After a substitute teacher has substituted for a period of 20 consecutive school days for a teacher with a temporary illness, compensation paid to the substitute teacher will be increased to the pro-rated salary of a beginning teacher at the Bachelors level. Should the duration of the illness exceed 45 consecutive school days, the substitute teacher shall be considered as a full-time substitute with compensation determined by written agreement with the Superintendent. No substitute is to be granted compensation in excess of the amount that would be paid a teacher with five years experience and equivalent study beyond the provisional teaching certificate on the established salary schedule without prior Board approval.
