# 2019 SENIOR AWARDS PROGRAM

- 1. VALEDICTORIAN SCHOLASTIC AWARD – to be announced during the ceremony**  
The Board of Education provides a monetary tribute of \$1,000 to the senior who has achieved academic excellence by being first in his/her class. The Board also provides a medal and plaque. PNC Bank awards \$250 in acknowledgement of this impressive accomplishment.
- 2. SALUTATORIAN SCHOLASTIC AWARD – to be announced during the ceremony**  
The Board of Education provides a medal and a monetary tribute of \$750 to the senior who has excelled in scholastic achievement and earned the second highest GPA in the class. Adprint, Inc. awards \$250 in acknowledgement of this notable accomplishment.
- 3. BILL AND LARUE HELM SCHOLASTIC AWARD – to be announced during the ceremony**  
LaRue Helm presents a check for \$500 to the third in class for excelling in scholastic achievement.
- 4. ABRAHAM LINCOLN AWARD – Ashley Grace Firestone**  
This \$1,000 award is provided by Dr. James and Mrs. Cheryl Duprey and is given to a senior who exemplified strength of character, integrity, and altruism while also overcoming obstacles during the high school tenure.
- 5. ACT – “AUTHENTIC, CARING & TRUSTWORTHY” AWARD – Sarah Demaree Dearnoff**  
A \$200 award, given by the Siegrist/Nolt Realty Group, is presented to a senior who is trustworthy and exemplifies selflessness and an authentic, caring spirit for others.
- 6. ATHLETIC AWARDS – Kelsey Noele Kimmel and Ezra Clark Mellinger**  
Outstanding male and female senior athletes are selected based upon participation, leadership, sportsmanship, and ability in athletics. The funds for these awards were set up through an endowment to the L-S Recreation Commission by the Gene Snyder estate, which provides the recipients with cash awards. A plaque is provided for each recipient by the L-S Athletic Department.
- 7. CREATIVE ARTS AWARD – Logan Dean Emmert**  
This \$200 award, provided by an anonymous donor, is given to a senior in the gifted program who will be attending college in the field of creative arts and who shares former gifted teacher Mrs. Harrington’s love for learning and the arts.
- 8. DR. ROBERT A. FRICK FOREVER A PIONEER SCHOLARSHIP – Katelyn Renee Graybeal**  
Through the L-S Educational Foundation, a scholarship for \$2,000 is presented to a deserving senior who will attend one of Pennsylvania’s 14 state-owned universities. The recipient is chosen by a committee based on criteria set up by Dr. and Mrs. Robert Frick.
- 9. DAVID B. AND KATHRYN M. KRAYBILL SCHOLARSHIP – Jansen Mark Miller**  
An L-S Educational Foundation scholarship of \$1,000, in memory of former L-S educators David B. and Kathryn M. Kraybill, is awarded to a senior who has demonstrated good attendance, discipline, and academics while in high school and is planning to attend post-secondary institution of higher learning.
- 10. THE DENISE M. PATCHES MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP – Amelia Shenandoah Cope**  
A \$1,000 scholarship, in memory of Denise M. Patches, is given to a senior who has been accepted into an institution of higher learning and is pursuing a degree in pre-medicine or biological/cancer research. This award is sponsored by the Patches Family.
- 11. THE DENISE M. PATCHES FAMILY AND FRIENDS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP – Kankika Viset**  
A \$1,300 scholarship, in memory of Denise M. Patches, is given to a senior who has been accepted into an institution of higher learning and is pursuing a degree in pre-medicine or biology/cancer research. This award is sponsored by the Family and Friends of Denise.
- 12. DENISE M. PATCHES MEMORIAL MATH  $\pi$  SCHOLARSHIP – Joshua Robert Kirchner**
