



## LAMPETER-STRASBURG SCHOOL DISTRICT

### FOOD SERVICES INFORMATION 2020/21

Welcome to the Lampeter-Strasburg School District! Our food service department offers nutritious breakfast and lunch options for all full-day students and children enrolled in our School Age Child Care (SACC) program. Our meals meet federal and state guidelines.

#### **What Is Available?**

Daily breakfast offerings include 2 servings whole grains or 2 servings meat or 1 of each, 2 servings of fruit and 1 serving milk. Lunch for grades 1-5 includes serving of meat, serving of grain, 2 vegetables, 1 fruit (fresh or canned) and choice of milk. Meat and grain servings are slightly larger for grades 6-8 and includes 2 vegetables, 1 fruit (fresh or canned) and choice of milk. Meat and grain servings are slightly larger for grades 9-12 and includes 2 vegetables, 2 fruits (fresh or canned) and choice of milk. Additional options are available for students in grades 6-12.

#### **How Much Do Meals Cost?**

Breakfast is \$1.55 for all grades. Lunch is \$2.60 for grades K-5, \$2.75 for grades 6-8, and \$3.00 or \$3.50 for grades 9-12. Milk costs \$.60. Free and reduced lunches are available by application. Application can be completed at: <https://www.schoolcafe.com>

#### **How Does It Work?**

Each child will be given a scan card that is linked to their account. They will simply scan the card when purchasing meals in the Cafeteria. Parents deposit money into the account to pay for school meals.

#### **How Can I Pay?**

The district has partnered with SchoolCafe for lunch accounts. We urge families with internet access to utilize with <https://www.schoolcafe.com> to deposit money into their children's lunch accounts. Alternately, money may be sent with your child (cash or checks) to the attention of the cafeteria staff. Checks should be made payable to L-S Cafeteria. **CASH FOR LUNCHES WILL NO LONGER BE ACCEPTED ON A DAILY BASIS.** If a patron has cash at lunch or breakfast, they WILL NOT receive change. The balance will be deposited into their account for future use.

#### **What Happens at the End of the Year?**

Money left in a student's account will move with that student to the next grade and/or building. If a student is leaving the district, the food service department will work with the family for reimbursement.
