



### **Gifted Teachers**

- There are two gifted teachers at the high school—Mrs. McCanna and Mrs. Depew:
  - Christy McCanna—christy\_mccanna@l-spioneers.org (also a social studies teacher)
  - Angela Depew—angela\_depew@l-spioneers.org (also an English teacher)
- Students will be assigned to a teacher at the start of the school year.
- Both teachers have Schoology group pages—students are placed into the group automatically, parents can be given the code if they would also like to join the group—students are encouraged to check Schoology to learn about gifted opportunities. Additionally, Schoology messages are a common way for Mrs. McCanna and Mrs. Depew to get in touch with students.

### **GIEP—Annual Reviews**

- As always, students will have an annual review of their GIEP. At the high school, students are welcomed and encouraged to attend their GIEP meetings.
- Both parents and students are asked to provide input to help make the GIEP as meaningful and individualized for each student as possible.
- Email is the most common way for us to contact parents, please make sure that you have updated your email information in PowerSchool to ensure that you are receiving information from your child's gifted teacher.

### **Course Selection**

- Each year, in grades 9-11, students will meet with their gifted teacher to discuss course selection. Gifted teachers make a great resource to help students understand their options and to provide clarification during the course selection process.
- It is the goal of the gifted program at Lampeter-Strasburg High School to ensure that students' schedules meet their individualized needs and goals while also ensuring that they meet all district and state graduation requirements.



### **Enrichment Opportunities**
