Parent Information

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In each English course, students will engage in some level of reading, writing, vocabulary and grammar study. Certain courses may appeal to a specific skill set.

Courses for students who like to read:

- Literary and Cinematic Analysis

Courses for students who like projects/hands on learning:

- Mass Media Literacy

Courses for students who like to write:

- Creative Writing
- Accelerated English and Communications
- HACC English 101

Courses for students who are college bound:

- British Literature
- Accelerated Composition and Syntactical Analysis
- Accelerated English and Communications
- AP English Literature and Composition
- HACC English 101
- Accelerated Shakespeare

A.P. and HACC courses:

- A.P. courses are college-level courses that teach a curriculum that has been approved by the College Board
- Students can pay \$94 to take the national A.P. examination in May.
- Students earn a score of 1-5 on the test. A three (3) is considered passing, but each college has their own standards for what scores they require on each individual A.P. exam. Students are not guaranteed college credit, but often with a score of 3, 4, or 5 may be able to earn advanced college credits.
- HACC 101 follows the HACC approved curriculum. Students pay a nominal fee required for HACC college credits. Students can earn three college credits by taking this course.
