Dear L-S Family,

We learned over the weekend that a member of the Lampeter Elementary School community has tested positive for COVID-19. We are sending our best wishes to this member of our school community. The individual will not be in school until they have recovered. With the long weekend, we were able to complete the case investigation, contact tracing, and the continued the cleaning and disinfecting of the school. With the school reopened to students today (1/26/21), we currently have zero active cases attributed to Lampeter Elementary School\*.

We are NOT closing Lampeter Elementary School, but will continue to clean and disinfect the school following recommendations from the CDC. We have worked with the Department of Health to complete the appropriate case investigation, contact tracing, and notifying everyone who was in close contact with the individual. The individuals who were in close contact will be quarantined at home for 14 days from their last exposure so that they can monitor their health and avoid spreading the illness to others.

While COVID-19 continues to spread in our community and across the country, please keep these important tips in mind:

- Practice physical (or social) distancing and stay at least 6 feet apart from people outside your household.
- Stay home when you are sick. If you have a cough, fever, shortness of breath, or other symptoms of COVID-19, stay home and contact your healthcare provider.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- Cover your coughs and sneezes with a tissue, and then dispose of the tissue and clean your hands immediately.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipes.
- Wear a mask or face covering in public spaces, including at school.
